Dawn to Dusk Charity Shoot

We are still looking for many of the time-slots to be filled on our charity shoot on Saturday 19th June. If you can shoot at any time between sunrise at 4.43am and sunset at 9.21pm (Note: you do not have to shoot all 16 ½ hours, just your chosen round at your chosen time), then please fill in your name on the list in the hut, or let a committee member know. Just pick one (or two) of the 32 GNAS rounds and come along during daylight hours to shoot it. That's all you have to do. Of course the reason for this challenge is to raise money for the charity United Response, who raise funds to arrange regular social activities for adults with learning difficulties and mental and physical disabilities in the Colchester area, so we also need sponsorship. Sponsorship forms can be picked-up from Nigel Brown or in the club hut. We would like to have at least 2 archers at the ground at any one time throughout the day and volunteers to provide refreshments would be very welcome.

CADAC AGM

This year's club AGM will be held on **Wednesday 9th June** at the club hut in Mill Road and will start at **7.30pm**. This meeting is open to ALL club members and is your chance to have a say in the running of the club. One topic that comes up almost every year is the rise in club fees and this year will be no exception. In the last year, the club has made a loss and while the club is still financially reasonably healthy, it does mean an increase of the membership fee will be likely. Before you criticise this decision, please remember the costs that the club incurs throughout the year, such as the new bosses, the rising cost of hiring the hall at the Gilbert School throughout the winter, the ground rent and the cost of electricity. The two annual tournaments and the taster days and beginner courses all raise funds for the club, but the bulk of the club's funds come from the members fees. If you know of any other ways of raising funds for the club, please let us know. If you have any thoughts or comments on this or any other matters regarding the running of the club, why not voice them at the AGM on June 9th?
