Colchester and District Archery Club Field Championship 2011

On Sunday 24th October, 20 archers shot a field shoot at the Mill Road ground. We did our best to simulate a field course, without having the benefit of woodland or an undulating surface strewn with fallen branches. What we did have was a flat field, a few props, some home-made animal targets and an enthusiastic group of archers. Targets were 'hand-crafted' by Lynette Fisher (who also organised the shoot), Robert Pawlowski and Paul Roberts and we did our best to put holes in them whilst shooting from platforms and ramps provided by Paul Kearse and Fred Todd. The field took a little longer to set-up than anticipated, but the shooting got underway at just after 10.30am. Two rounds of 14 targets later, the shooting was over at just after 4pm. Thankfully a 'soup kitchen', organised by Barbara Knight, had been providing the archers with their dietary needs and together with the warm autumn sunshine, the shoot was considered by most to be a big success. Thank you to all those mentioned above and to anyone else who provided equipment, advice and help on the day.

We hope to do the same thing again next year - if we cannot find a suitable field course, but if you have any suggestions for alternative venues or ideas, then please let us know.
