Medal haul for Colchester archers at the Braintree open Worcester competition.

On Sunday 27th January four archers from Colchester and District Archery Club took part in the Braintree Open Worcester competition at the Halstead Sports Centre.

The Worcester round consists of 60 arrows, shot at a distance of 20 yards. Each archer shoots five arrows per end at a black target face with a white Centre spot, this white spot is worth five points and the remaining rings decreasing from four to one on the outside of the target face, a maximum score of 300.

Anna and James King shot in the Compound category and Fred Todd and Ed Kearse shot in the Recurve category.

Anna King (296) won gold in the Ladies Compound. James King won gold in the Gentleman's Compound (299). Ed Kearse won gold in the Junior Gents Recurve (273) and Fred Todd came third in the Gents Recurve (271). Anna and James also took gold in the married couples classification.
