### **Gold and Bronze Medals for Colchester Archers at the Record Status Stafford round held in Norwich**

On Sunday 13 January two Colchester archers competed in the annual Record Status Stafford archery competition in Norwich. For this round archers aim at a target 30m away, Anna and James King shot in the compound category.

Scoring a maximum 10 points for each arrow, the centre of the target was about the size of a 10p coin! Each Archer shot 3 arrows per end, this being timed to a maximum of 2 minutes, a total of 60 arrows shot.

After 6 dozen arrows the scores were added up and out of a maximum score of 720, Anna King won the ladies compound class with 666 and 22 10s and James King came 3rd in the men's compound class also on 666 and with 20 10s. 1st and 2nd place archers Michael Saunders of Suffolk and David Long of Norfolk both scored 669.

A very good display from the Colchester couple, both are hoping for UK rankings this year. The club is going from strength to strength with its junior and senior archers shooting at many competitions.

The club is holding its annual "Bill Tucker Memorial Shoot" on the 27<sup>th</sup> April at its Mill Road Range.
