Colchester & District Archery Club take honours at Basildon Shot

It was a real husband and wife affair at the Rackett's Worcester shoot on Sunday at Basildon. With over 120 competitors taking part, shooting Recurve, compound and long bows.

A Worcester round is shot on a black and white face rather than the traditional coloured one, with five scoring rings, five for the centre and decreasing to 1 on the outer ring. As with most indoor rounds, the Worcester is shot over 20 yards, but shooting five arrows per end rather than 3, 60 arrows in total with a maximum highest score of 300.

The compound classes were dominated by husband and wife James and Anna King. James scored an impressive 297 out of 300 and Anna did equally well with 294 out of 300. Both took gold in the Ladies and Gentleman's Compound categories.
